SUBJECT:

Interlocal Agreement with West Point Police

Recommendation: Move to approve the Interlocal Agreement between Fremont, Dodge County and West Point to allow the sharing of public safety servers.

Background:

Fremont/Dodge County 911, Fremont Police and the Dodge County Sheriff have purchased a shared computer aided dispatch/records management system from Zuercher Technologies. The system has adequate capacity to host smaller agencies who may need certain modules for their operations but can't purchase a full suite of hardware/software.

West Point Police Department is one such agency. They are purchasing modules to conduct ecitations as per state requirements but do not wish to purchase a full records management system. They have requested that Fremont/Dodge County host them on our system. In return, they will pay a portion of the yearly server support agreement, based on their number of users. The Interlocal agreement spells out the conditions of the relationship.

The Shared System Acknowledgement is a form that Zuercher Technologies has requested both agencies sign for their records.

The PSAP Governing Board voted unanimously to move forward with the Interlocal Agreement and the project.

Fiscal Impact: \$2000 yearly remittance as the West Point share of the support contract, with a 5% yearly increase.
