NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on September 25, 2019 in the Third Floor, Courthouse, Fremont, Nebraska the Dodge County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing concerning an application to the Nebraska Department of Economic Development for a Community Development Block Grant. This grant is available to local governments for community/ economic development activities.

Dodge County is requesting \$485,000 for Emergent Threat Disaster Funds for flood damage repairs of the Ames Dike Drainage system. The total estimated project cost is \$2,118,000, with CDBG funds requested and project activities will include \$450,000 Flood Control and Drainage; \$10,000 Construction Management; and \$25,000 General Administration. Matching and leverage funds of \$1,633,000 will be provided by Corps of Engineers and Ames Dike Drainage District. This project will meet the Emergent Threat National Objective. The project will take place on farmland and recreational land, there will not be displacement of people as a result of the CDBG activities.

The grant application will be available for public inspection at Dodge County Courthouse Clerk's Office. All interested parties are invited to attend this public hearing at which time you will have an opportunity to be heard regarding the grant application. Written and oral testimony will also be accepted at the public hearing scheduled for 9:15 A.M., September 25, 2019, Third Floor, Courthouse, 435 N Park, Fremont Ne. Written comments addressed to Fred Mytty at 435 N Park, Fremont, NE 68025 will be accepted if received on or before September 25, 2019.
