Interlocal Cooperation Agreement Between the Village of Dodge County

WHEREAS, both of the parties hereto are political subdivisions of the State of Nebraska, and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §13-801 to §13-827, permits local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers to enable them to cooperate with other governmental units in an effort to provide services and facilities in a manner that will accord with the needs of their local communities; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Village of <u>loge</u>, that in emergency situations such as snow, tornados, floods, etc. that Dodge County may assist the Village of <u>lodge</u> in the removal of snow, debris, and/or other emergency clean up or repairs in such a manner as to facilitate returning the Village of <u>lodge</u> to as close to normal conditions as practical, using the equipment and resources of either entity as may be agreed, and with the County Board Chairperson being the administrator of this agreement, and

WHEREAS, Dodge County will assist, when able, the Village of _______ upon the request of the Village's representative and will perform assistance under the supervision, direction and control of the Village although county employees will remain county employees at all times during the emergency assistance to the Village of ______, and

WHEREAS, the Village of <u>loge</u> agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, protect and defend Dodge County and its elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, and representatives against any and all claims, demands, suits, actions, payments and judgments, including any and all costs and expenses connected therewith, legal cost or otherwise, for any damages which may be asserted, claimed, or recovered against or from Dodge County or its insurers, because of personal injury, including bodily injury or death, or on account of property damage, including loss of use thereof, sustained by any person or persons which arises out of, is in any way connected with, or results from any and all work or activity associated with the services provided under this agreement unless such damages are the direct and sole result of Dodge County's gross negligence, and

WHEREAS, this agreement will continue, until either entity withdraws from said agreement or terminates the same upon written notification to the other party.

WHEREAS, no separate legal entity is created by this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of $\frac{1}{2}$ and Dodge County agree to the contents of the above agreement.
