As a follow-up to questions about the demographic information I presented at the Dodge County Board meeting on October 7, below is additional data for your review:

Increased Expenditures

In FY 19 there was a 37% increase in expenditures for Dodge county totaling \$196,812.15. Seven services saw an increase of at least \$15,000 for FY 19.

Adults, Ages 25-34 by Service

1. In FY 19 there was a 50% increase in the number of adults, ages 25-34 who were served through Region 6-funded services in comparison to FY 18:

2. Assessment – Substance Use Disorder (SUD), Medication Management – Mental Health, and Outpatient Psychotherapy – Mental Health all saw significant increases in service provision for this population.
