4. METHODIST FREMONT HEALTH

Annual Report - Brett Richmond, President/CEO of Methodist Fremont Health presented the 2020 Annual Report to the FCHR Board of Trustees in addition to reviewing the Capital Report as of December 31, 2020. He noted while routine capital is under \$3M for the year due to the pandemic, dollars will forward to the next year. EMR integration with the NMHS system is nearly complete with the transitioning of the Surgery Center in late 2021. Board approved the Strategic Plan for 2021-2023. All planned centralized and integration efforts were completed as of December 31, 2020. Mr. Richmond shared information regarding budgets, COVID-19, Physician Recruitment, specialty clinics, Urgent Care and the MD West ONE partnership. The Lobby Renovation Project, to include the main lobby, physician lounge, and surgery waiting, will be funded by the Fremont Health Foundation.

5. PENSION FUND & PLAN

Actuarial Report - At the February meeting, Glen Gahan, with Silverstone/HUB presented the Fremont Health Restated Pension Plan Actuarial Report dated January 1, 2021.
