Dear, Fremont & Dodge County Convention & Visitors Bureau,

The city staff are working with the Project Dream Field Committee and the Hooper Area Community Foundation to complete the Project Dream Field Project. The total project budget was \$330,000. An additional \$70,000.00 in costs came in with the city's recommendation to go with LED lighting due to future maintenance and operating costs to the city. The city has committed funds in their new Budget to help with the additional costs. Field grading, drainage issues, and electrical upgrades may come in at an additional \$38,000.00.

We do want to mention that the donations have exceeded our expectations and the project is nearing completion. We would like the Fremont & Dodge County Convention & Visitors Bureau to consider our request for an additional \$10,000.00 to help defray additional costs. I have included a summary of expenses. 

70 years ago, the Town of Hooper had a vision. Realizing the advent of night baseball would be the wave of the future, leaders in the community made the bold decision to add lighting to its baseball field. Through their aggressive efforts, sufficient funds were raised to purchase a state of the art lighting system. Those lights have provided evening baseball and softball entertainment for Hooper and the surrounding area since 1950. Hooper has always had a rich tradition of baseball excellence bringing two (2) American Legion State Championships, one (1) State runner up, and numerous Dodge County League Titles to the City due to its unwavering support of its baseball programs. Those proud accomplishments were spawned under the lights of Hooper's baseball field.

In recent years, however, the field has been in decline, and the original lighting system has become a safety concern. Nighttime play may soon have to be abandoned.

Recognizing the urgent need to upgrade its facilities, a group of citizens formed a committee to determine which areas require specific attention. A former native of Hooper, inspired by Kevin Costner's 1989 movie, "Field of Dreams," also expressed a lifelong desire to renovate the field by pledging matching funds which would elevate it to a first-class playing facility.

With the theme, "If we rebuild it, they will come," the committee has endorsed a plan to renovate the entire field.

Five (5) major areas were identified as the core of the project: 1. Lighting, 2. Seating, 3. Fencing, 4. Scoreboard, 5. Dugouts and press box. Those subjects were addressed in detail, with cost estimates for each area, to establish the overall scope of the project. From that analysis, the Committee has determined the total cost of the renovations will be approximately \$330,000.

A project of this magnitude will require considerable funding from outside philanthropic agencies to reduce the City's financial commitment in its fund raising endeavors. It is hoped that nearly half of the project costs will be provided by grants.

With the quest for grant funding currently in progress, the Committee is launching a community campaign to raise the remaining funds for the project. It will be soliciting all individuals, businesses, and organizations in the community and surrounding area. Matching funds, as defined in the Project Funding, have also been pledged to the campaign. Upon successfully achieving both campaign goals, the renovations will commence with an estimated completion date of June 2020.

When Project Dream Field becomes reality, Hooper will be the beneficiary of a new state of the art baseball facility at a fraction of the cost to its citizens and businesses. It will provide a premier playing venue for its youth and young adults in the community while being an asset proudly showcased for many years to come. Officials in the Region, seeking sites for future baseball and softball events, will find Dream Field to be a most attractive choice.

Just as the City of Hooper had a vision 70 years ago, the community is again being challenged to enthusiastically embrace this much needed and worthy project.
