

Be an Everyday Hero! Help end human trafficking!

Slavery has been illegal for centuries, human trafficking has created more slaves today than ever before. It's happening to our own children in all 50 states and DC, along most of our highways and in locations including truck stops, motels/hotels, strip clubs, private homes, rest areas, etc. Traffickers control their victims through force, fraud and coercion. Any minor engaged in commercial sex is a victim of human trafficking. If you see a minor working any of these areas or suspect the person selling sex is under someone's control to make a quota, make a call and save lives.

If you suspect you're seeing human trafficking, call 911 and the National Human Trafficking Hotline at 1–888–3737–888 (US) or text INFO or HELP to BeFree (233733)

Calls to the hotline can be anonymous. Provide descriptions of cars and people involved, specific times and dates, addresses and locations where the suspicious activity took place.

Red Flags to look for:

- Does the victim know her/his whereabouts and have control of own ID/passport?
- Is there restricted or controlled communication victim not allowed to speak for self?
- Have you heard CB chatter about "commercial company" or flashing lights signaling "buyer" location?
- Is there acknowledgement of a pimp and making a quota?
- Are there signs of branding or tattooing of a trafficker's name (often on the neck)?
- Does a van or RV seem out of place back by trucks; a vehicle dropping someone off at a truck and returning 15–20 minutes later for pick—up of a person?

Remember:

Don't approach traffickers. Allow law enforcement to deal with traffickers and recover victims. Approaching traffickers is dangerous for you and the victims. Also, anyone using their CMV to commit a felony involving a severe form of human trafficking will receive a lifetime CDL ban. All 50 states and DC have a law criminalizing sex trafficking. Some states punish purchasers the same as sex traffickers, and 31 states have a buyer—applicable trafficking law prohibiting mistake—of—age defense in prosecutions for buying a commercial sex act with any minor under 18.

- Permittee acknowledges that the vehicle or load cannot be dismantled or reduced in size or weight without great difficulty to meet the statutory size and/or weight limits.
- Any dummy axle must carry at least the lessor of 8,000 pounds or 8% of the total gross weight.
- Route analysis is based on the maximum single axle weight of 25,000 pounds per axle, tandem axle weight of 47,000 pounds, triple axle weight of 60,000 pounds or the quad axle weight of 80,000 pounds. Permittee may reduce axle or group axle weights to actual if desired for analysis, however, if the maximum axle or group axle weights are changed by the permittee, it is the permittees responsibility to insure that the actual axle or group axle weights on the permit vehicle do not exceed those shown on the permit. Enforcement will be based on the axle weights shown on the permit.
- No single axle weight greater than 20,000 pounds is allowed on the Interstate System.
- In no case shall the maximum gross weight exceed 94,000 pounds on a four axle unit, 107,000 pounds on a five axle unit, or 120,000 pounds on a six axle unit.
- If load is only overweight, movement is allowed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Permittee agrees to hold harmless the State of Nebraska, its agents/employees, contractors and subcontractors from all suits, damages, or proceedings of any kind and to indemnify the State of Nebraska, its agents/employees, contractors and subcontractors for any claims it may be required to pay arising from the permitted move.
- Permittee agrees to hold harmless the State of Nebraska, its agents/employees contractors and subcontractors from all suits, damages, or proceedings of any kind arising from fraudulent use of the user's login/password regarding escrow transactions or unauthorized request for

Be an Everyday Hero! Help end human trafficking!

Slavery has been illegal for centuries, human trafficking has created more slaves today than ever before. It's happening to our own children in all 50 states and DC, along most of our highways and in locations including truck stops, motels/hotels, strip clubs, private homes, rest areas, etc. Traffickers control their victims through force, fraud and coercion. Any minor engaged in commercial sex is a victim of human trafficking. If you see a minor working any of these areas or suspect the person selling sex is under someone's control to make a quota, make a call and save lives.

If you suspect you're seeing human trafficking, call 911 and the National Human Trafficking Hotline at 1–888–3737–888 (US) or text INFO or HELP to BeFree (233733)

Calls to the hotline can be anonymous. Provide descriptions of cars and people involved, specific times and dates, addresses and locations where the suspicious activity took place.

Red Flags to look for:

- Does the victim know her/his whereabouts and have control of own ID/passport?
- Is there restricted or controlled communication victim not allowed to speak for self?
- Have you heard CB chatter about "commercial company" or flashing lights signaling "buyer" location?
- Is there acknowledgement of a pimp and making a quota?
- Are there signs of branding or tattooing of a trafficker's name (often on the neck)?
- Does a van or RV seem out of place back by trucks; a vehicle dropping someone off at a truck and returning 15–20 minutes later for pick—up of a person?

Remember:

Don't approach traffickers. Allow law enforcement to deal with traffickers and recover victims. Approaching traffickers is dangerous for you and the victims. Also, anyone using their CMV to commit a felony involving a severe form of human trafficking will receive a lifetime CDL ban. All 50 states and DC have a law criminalizing sex trafficking. Some states punish purchasers the same as sex traffickers, and 31 states have a buyer–applicable trafficking law prohibiting mistake–of–age defense in prosecutions for buying a commercial sex act with any minor under 18.
