Elkhorn River Streambank Repair at Scribner – Engineer's Recommendation

Dear Curt, Elmer and Scott:

The bid opening for the above-referenced project was held at the LENRD on 19 July 2022. The low bid of \$131,334.00 was received from Pruss Excavation Co. of Dodge, NE. This bid was significantly below the Engineer's Opinion of Probable Costs shown in the attached bid sheet. All required documents accompanied the bid. The other three bids are listed below:

Niewohner Construction, Inc.

\$173,965.60

Graham Construction, Inc.

\$190,970.00

Bauer Infrastructure

\$279,105.00

The difference in the low bid and the engineer's estimate is spread pretty evenly across the project. In order to both be conservative with the estimate, and to reflect much higher than normal bid prices being realized in recent years on FEMA repair projects (and most others), we were pretty conservative in our estimates.

FYRA has worked with Pruss Excavation in the past and believes that they are a quality contractor. I also received good feedback on them working personally with LENRD staff and management and understood it was a good experience.

I spoke w/ Matt Pruss this morning and while he is not ready to commit to a start date due to current projects, he is confident that he can get the job done within the allotted time frames laid out in the bid documents.

For the reasons stated above, my recommendation is to award the project to Pruss Excavation and begin the contracting process upon Board approval. As always, please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
