## INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

Come now the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District (hereinafter "LENRD"), the City of Scribner, Nebraska (hereinafter "Scribner") and Dodge County, Nebraska (hereinafter "Dodge County"), and agree as follows:

- 1. The Project. This Agreement relates to the "Streambank Stabilization Repair Project" (the "Project"), originally constructed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in 2015, in which Dodge County, the LENRD and the City of Scribner, Nebraska were partners.
- 2. Additional Rock Riprap. In constructing such Project, Dodge County shall donate 499 ton of rock riprap, but an additional 947.54 ton of rock riprap is required, which shall be furnished by Dodge County.
- 3. <u>Payment</u>. It is hereby agreed that the cost of such 947.54 ton of rock riprap shall be separately agreed to by the parties to this Agreement, and the cost of the same shall be paid equally by the LENRD, Dodge County and Scriber, after any contribution by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA).
- 4. Approval of Governing Body. Each person signing this Agreement represents that appropriate action by ordinance, resolution, or other act was taken by the governing bodies of the respective parties to approve this Agreement.
