Economic Development Portion: If Proposition No. 2 passes, 100% of the one and one- half percent (1 ½%) City Sales and Use Tax provided for in this Proposition No. 1 shall be allocated to the Economic Development Program as provided for in the Plan described in Proposition No. 2.  2. Termination of Tax: The one and one-half percent (1 ½%) City Sales and Use Tax shall automatically terminate on September 30, 2039, unless the tax is extended by a vote of the electorate prior to that date. Source of Funds: The source for Economic Development Funds shall be the City Sales and Use Tax provided for in Proposition No. 1. The city may issue bonds pursuant to the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act. f. Total Amount to be Collected: The total amount to be collected from local sources of revenue shall be the lesser of (1) approximately \$110,000 for fiscal year 2024-2025 and then approximately \$110,000 per year for an additional 14 years, or (2) the amounts allocated to the Economic Development Program pursuant to the City Sales and Use Tax provided for in Proposition No. 1. g.
