1. WELCOME

The meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to order at 12:10 pm by Larry Shepard, President.

A current copy of the Open Meetings Act was available.

2. MINUTES

The minutes of the Fremont Community Health Resources Board of Trustees meetings of November 12, 2019 were available prior to meeting on the Board Webport.

MOTION: Moved by McClain and seconded by Pribnow to approve the minutes of the November Board meeting. Motion carried.

3. FINANCE & ACCOUNTING

<u>Financial Statements</u> - The November, 2019 Financial Statements were presented. Specific questions related to the monthly expenses were answered.

MOTION: Moved by McClain and seconded by Pribnow to accept and approve the November 2019 Financial Statements. Motion carried.

4. PENSION FUND & PLAN

Mr. Booth reviewed the November Investment Statement from FNBO noting the balance as of November 30 of \$73,191,035.52. FNBO continues to reduce the cash balance to 2% as allocated by the Investment Policy.

5. INSURANCE

Fiduciary Policy - Mr. Booth stated he is waiting to receive the premium quote from Harry A. Koch for the Fiduciary Policy Premium. He reviewed the policy coverage, deductible and preliminary premium information provided by Mr. Unger from the Harry A. Koch Co. Since the policy is effective 1/1/20, Mr. Booth requested authorization to approve the renewal of the policy and payment for the premium.

MOTION: Moved by McClain and seconded by Pribnow to authorize Patrick Booth, Executive Director, to approve the renewal of the Fiduciary Policy and payment of the premium, unless there is a significant rate increase from the preliminary premium amount provided by the insurance company. Motion carried.

Current policies in place are General Liability and Directors & Officers.

6. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Actuarial Valuation - Mr. Booth has been in contact with Silverstone regarding the annual Actuarial Valuation. They are prepared to complete the Valuation in January and present to the Board in February.

<u>Letter to Pension Participants</u> - Mr. Booth has drafted a letter to the pension participants and recommends it would be beneficial to send after the Actuarial Valuation, in the January/February timeframe, in lieu of this year as discussed last month. The Board concurred.

Report from Methodist Fremont Health - The Board requested an overall annual report from MFH to include Services, commitment to capital, charity care, etc. to be assured the Strategic Partnership Objectives are being met. The Board discussed the duration of bonds related to the investment strategy.
