Nebraska under Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 31-727 to 31-793, as amended; the real estate included in said District is as heretofore described herein.


- 2. The five trustees nominated in the Articles of Association of said District are hereby declared to be the Board of Trustees of said District to serve until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

# ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 9

DODGE COUNTY, NEBRASKA

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Sanitary and Improvement District under the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 31-727 to 31-793, as amended, and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Association:

## ARTICLE FIRST

The name of this District shall be Sanitary and Improvement District No. 9 of Dodge County, Nebraska.

## ARTICLE SECOND

This District shall have perpetual existence.

## ARTICLE THIRD

The limits of this District and the area embraced therein shall be as described and drawn on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

## ARTICLE FOURTH

The undersigned subscribers are tenants-in-common owners of all of the land in said proposed District. The names and addresses of those joining in the formation and organization of the District are as follows:

There are no parties holding a lien against the real property to be included in the District.

#### ARTICLE FIFTH

There are no known or unknown owners of real property who will be benefited by the District and who have not joined in its organization or who are nonresidents of Nebraska.

#### ARTICLE SIXTH

The purposes of the District shall be to acquire, install, repair, maintain, renew, reconstruct, and replace a sanitary and storm sewer system, disposal plants, a water system, a system of sidewalks, public roads, streets, highways, public waterways, docks or wharfs and related appurtenances; to provide for collection and disposal of drainage, waste, and sewage in a satisfactory manner; to install an emergency management warning system; to contract for water for fire protection and for resale to residents of the District, to contract for police protection and security services, to contract for solid waste collection services, to contract for access to the facilities and use of the services of the library system of one or more neighboring cities or villages, and to contract for gas and for electricity for street lighting for the public streets and highways within the District; to construct electric service lines and conduits, and gas mains, or to contract for the installation and operation thereof; to acquire, build, improve and operate, or, where permitted by law, to contract with other sanitary and improvement districts to acquire, build, improve, and operate public parks, playgrounds and recreational facilities for the joint use of the residents of the contracting districts; and to construct and to contract for the construction of dikes and levees for flood protection for the District. In lieu of establishing its own water system, the District may contract with any utilities district, municipality or corporation for the installation of a water system and to provide water service for fire protection and for use of the residents of the District. The District may contract with the city or county within whose zoning jurisdiction it is located for intersection and traffic control improvements, which improvements serve or benefit the district and which may be within or without the corporate boundaries of the district and for any of the purposes for which it is formed. The District may also enter into agreements with other public agencies in order to accomplish the purposes of, and pursuant to, the provisions of the Nebraska Interlocal Cooperation Act; and do any and all other activities or functions allowed by the Reissued, Revised Statutes of Nebraska as the same may be amended from time to time.

#### ARTICLE SEVENTH

The undersigned subscribers and owners of real estate so forming this District for such purposes, are willing and obligate themselves to pay the tax or taxes which may be levied against all the property in the District and special assessments against the real property benefited which may be assessed against them, to pay the expenses that may be necessary to install a sewer system or water system, or both, within the district, as provided by law; to pay the expenses that may be necessary to construct a system of sidewalks; and to pay the expenses that may be necessary for obtaining water for fire protection and for resale to residents of the District, and the cost of grading, changing grade, paving, repairing, graveling, regraveling, widening or narrowing sidewalks and roads, resurfacing or relaying existing pavement, or otherwise improving any

public roads, streets or highways within the District, including protecting existing sidewalks, streets, highways, and roads from floods or erosion which has moved within fifteen feet from the edge of such sidewalks, streets, highways, or roads, regardless of whether such flooding or erosion is of natural or artificial origin; the cost of constructing or contracting for the construction of dikes and levees for flood protection for the District, public waterways, docks or wharfs and related appurtenances; the cost of gas and electricity for street lighting for the public streets and highways within the District; the cost of collection and disposal of drainage, waste and sewage or contracting for collection and disposal of same; the cost of constructing and installing an emergency management warning system, gas mains and electric service lines and conduits; the cost of contracting for fire protection, police protection and security services; the cost of contracting for access to the facilities and use of the services of the library system of one or more neighboring cities or villages; the cost of acquiring, improving, and operating public parks, playgrounds and recreational facilities, as provided by law; the cost of contracting for building, acquiring, improving and operating public parks, playgrounds and recreational facilities as provided by law; the costs of intersection and traffic control improvements, which improvements serve or benefit the district and which may be within or without the corporate boundaries of the district; the cost or expenses incurred pursuant to any agreement under the Nebraska Interlocal Cooperation Act; and the cost to do all other things incidental thereto and connected therewith which are not forbidden by the laws of the State of Nebraska or by these Articles of Association, all as provided by law.

## **ARTICLE EIGHTH**

The powers of this District shall be all powers granted by Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 31-727 to 31-793, inclusive, as amended, and all powers granted to corporations by the laws of the State of Nebraska, as the same may be amended from time to time.

## **ARTICLE NINTH**

The following named persons are proposed as designated representative Trustees to serve on behalf of FWFH, LLC, a Nebraska limited liability company, and FOZC, LLC, a Nebraska limited liability company, owners of the property within the District as described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, as a Board of Trustees of the District until their successors are elected and qualified:

All of the foregoing Trustees will serve as the designated representatives of FWFH, LLC, a Nebraska limited liability company, and FOZC, LLC, a Nebraska limited liability company, property owners within the District.


