Dear Dodge County Clerk:

The Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration have jointly issued regulations requiring a separate consultation process with the non-metropolitan officials in order to provide an additional opportunity for input into the development of statewide plans and programs. I would appreciate your input on the FY 2022 through FY 2025 portion of the State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP).

As a reminder, the STIP is a four-year document, which contains all federally funded FY 2021 projects and all projects that are regionally significant, regardless of funding source. These projects have been through the review process, and are set and fundable. The STIP also contains federally funded projects and all projects that are regionally significant, regardless of funding source from FY 2022 through FY 2025. This is an opportunity to provide input on the FY 2022 through FY 2025 transportation projects included in the STIP.


