To Dodge County Board of Supervisors

The City of Scribner requests that the county board include in their 1&6 road plan, the paving of the ¼-mile section of County Road F/Scribner-Herman road from the West Scribner city limits to the proposed four lane U.S. 275 bypass. This section is entirely in the county. The City plans to pave the approximate 1/8-mile section of County Road F from the existing U.S. 275 West to the city limits. The North half of this section of County Road F is in the county, while the South half is in the city limits.

During the past 3 years there has been much discussion between the County, City, and State concerning the need for paving this section of County Road F. The State has declined to pave this section due to the height of fill involved and meeting state highway standards. County road standards are not the same as those required for state highways.

With the new U.S. 275 bypass, this ¼-mile section of the Scribner-Herman road will be the only gravel in the 24 miles extending from U.S. 75 to U.S. 77 to U.S. 275.
