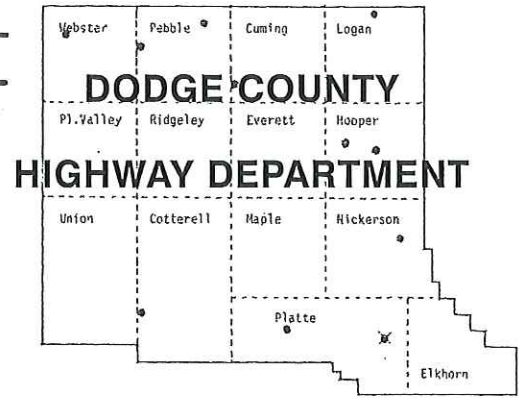

Honorable Members of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors

I am submitting my study of the vacation of County Road U Blvd. and Road 29 located in the Southeast Corner of Section 14, Township 17 North, Range 9 East of the 6th P.M. This road is 33 feet in width and approximately 840 feet in length.

Elkhorn Township Board members request this road be vacated due to the construction of the Union Pacific Railroad bridge near this intersection.

I would recommend the vacation of U Blvd. and Road 29 as it would not provide any hardships to landowners or the traveling public. However, a thirty-three foot wide utility easement should be allowed on this property to maintain present and future utilities. I further recommend the right-of-way be deeded to the adjoining property owners and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds.
