To avoid any possible liability issues and save the expense of having the graphics removed from the vehicle exterior and repairing the vehicle interior I would request authorization to take the vehicle to All Metals to be scrapped. I feel that the minimal amount that this vehicle would bring at auction would not be worth the expense of any further action. Although the vehicle has only 103,286 miles, the hours on the motor are extremely high, due to the necessity of leaving the vehicle running to control the temperature for the K9.
