INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

Sealed Bids will be received by the Road and Bridge Committee of Dodge County, hereafter called the Owner, in the office of the Dodge County Highway Department, Rm. 204, 2nd Floor of the Courthouse, Fremont, NE at <u>11:15 A.M.</u> Local Time on the <u>10th</u> day of <u>June, 2022</u> and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Each Bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope addressed to the Dodge Highway Dept, 435 N. Park, Fremont, NE 68025. Each sealed envelope containing a bid must be plainly marked on the outside as bid for **DODGE COUNTY ROAD GRAVEL**, and the envelope shall bear on the outside the name of the Bidder and their address. Each bid shall be time stamped on the outside of the envelope at the Dodge County Highway Dept. Office prior to opening time.

All bids shall be submitted on the Contract and Specifications form supplied by the Dodge County Highway Department. All blank spaces to be bid shall be filled in with ink or typewritten and the bid form shall be fully completed and signed prior to opening time. SECTION 5E

SPECIFICATIONS

The Bidder agrees that the **price per ton per township** shall include the following requirements:

- #1. All labor, fuel, equipment, material, supplies, tools and staking of the various mail route roads.
- #2. Delivered and spread evenly to the various townships according to the stakes.
- #3. Conform to the State of Nebraska Specifications of "Graveling for Surfacing". See Exhibit A.
- #4. **Tonnage weights** are to be actual weights over State of Nebraska Inspected Scales. Scale Tickets for each load shall be included with the invoice or statement. Bottom dump type trailers shall be in-cab air open and air closed.
- #5. A conversion factor of 1.40 shall be used to compute the tons to cubic yards and cubic yards to tons.
- #6. A minimum of 150 tons per working day delivered and spread in each township staked. Failure to deliver the 150 tons per working day per township shall give the County the option of purchasing gravel through other contracts. Working days shall be construed to mean each day except Sundays and Holidays that the weather or road conditions are such that the contractor can work.
- #7. Furnishing the Owner with evidence that the road gravel specifications are being met upon request of the Owner.
- #8. The Contract and Specifications shall be in effect from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.
- #9. The estimated quantity of this Contract is 2,500 more or less tons per township and the Bidder agrees to deliver same be it more or less.
- #10. Payment to the Bidder from the Owner shall be monthly on forms approved by the Owner prior to payment.
- #11. The Bidders shall be required prior to be Awarding of Township Gravel Contracts an Insurance Certificate. Certificate holder shall be: The Dodge County Highway Department certifying the following minimum insurance coverages.
