

MARRIAGE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Minimum age to marry in Nebraska without parental consent is 19.
Individuals who are 17 and 18 years old may marry with a parent or guardian consent. The form can be picked up at the county clerk's office or filled out in the office in person.
- 2) Both applicants must present a government issued photo ID such as a driver's license, state ID or a passport.
- 3) Applicants must supply the names of their parents (including mother's maiden name), and their parents' place of birth (city and state or foreign country).
- 4) Social Security numbers of both applicants are requested on the marriage license application.
- 5) The fee for a marriage license is \$50.00 which would need to be paid in cash or check. We do not accept debit/credit cards.
- 6) Both applicants will need to sign the license. If one is unable to be present, please discuss your options with our office.

Once you are married and paperwork has been returned to our office, you will be able to obtain a certified copy of your license for a fee of \$16.00 (cash or check).

If you are getting married outside of Nebraska, you need to obtain a marriage license from the state or county your ceremony will be performed in.

A license issued in the state of Nebraska can be used in any county in Nebraska. There is no waiting period in Nebraska and you will be issued your license the same day as long as all requirements above have been met.

You have 1 year from the date the marriage license is issued to be married with that license.
