## PROCEEDINGS OF THE DODGE COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

A scheduled meeting of the Dodge County Board of Equalization was called to order by Chairman Missel at 9:00 A.M. on Monday, July 23, 2018 in the Board Room of the Courthouse, Fremont, Nebraska with the following members present: Saalfeld, Weddle, Strand, George, Beam and Missel. Absent: Vaughan. Prior to roll call, Chairman Missel announced the meeting to be an open public meeting and that the current open meeting laws were posted on the wall and available for anyone's review. (Supervisor George entered the meeting room at approximately 9:05 A.M.)

The Board unanimously declared the meeting legally convened.

The Board unanimously approved the agenda as printed.

The Board unanimously approved a list of 2018 changes to real property valuations requested by County Assessor Churchill and passed a motion authorizing the County Clerk to send Notices of Valuation Changes reflecting these changes.

For the next couple of hours, the Board acted on the remaining 263 valuation protests for 2018, denying any change in the valuation of 122, lowering the valuation of 137 and raising the valuation of 4.

The Board unanimously passed a motion rescinding action taken at the last meeting of July 18, 2018 on protest #69 of denying any change to the valuation.

In another motion, the Board unanimously accepted the recommendation of the County Assessor and lowered the valuation of protest #69, for a total valuation of \$152,170.

At 11:20 A.M., the Board adjourned as a Board of Equalization until 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, August 1, 2018.
