INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

The following are instructions on how to vote your ballot. Please follow these instructions precisely, otherwise, your ballot may not be counted.

1. Verify that there are initials of an election official at the bottom of the ballot.
2. Verify that there are no voting marks on the ballot.
3. Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot.
4. TO VOTE, you must darken the oval (●) completely.
5. Do NOT cross out or erase. If you make a mistake, contact the County Clerk's office at (402) 727-2767 for instructions.
6. Place voted ballot into the return envelope. Write your NE driver's license or state ID in the space provided on the envelope, or enclose a photocopy of an acceptable photo ID or Reasonable Impediment Certification (if applicable). Complete, SIGN and seal the envelope. Remember to moisten both seals to cover the voter ID and signature boxes.
7. Any person physically unable to sign the envelope must make his/her "mark" and must have an individual witness. Failure to complete and sign the Return Identification Envelope will cause the ballot to be rejected.
8. Do NOT place more than ONE (1) voted ballot into the return identification envelope.
9. Return Ballot by:
 - a. Hand Delivery - deliver the ballot to the office of the County Clerk/Election Commissioner.
 - b. Mail - return ballot by mail by placing proper return postage on the envelope.
 - c. Drop Box Location: 435 N. Park St., Fremont, NE., Enter alley on 4th St., drop box on west side
10. Ballot MUST be in the possession of the County Clerk's office by 5:00 p.m. Central Time on February 11, 2025.

North Bend Rural Fire District Bond

"Shall The North Bend Rural Fire District, in the State of Nebraska, issue its negotiable bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed Three Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,400,000) for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing and equipping a new fire hall, with such bonds to be issued and sold from time to time and on such terms, to bear interest at rate or rates and to become due at such time or times, all as may be authorized by the Board of Directors; and

"Shall the North Bend Rural Fire District, in the State of Nebraska, cause to be levied a tax of not to exceed 10.5 cents on each \$100 of value in any one year upon the taxable value of all taxable property within the District, subject to the limitation set forth in Section 35-508(13)(b), Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 2008, for the purposes of paying principal of and interest on the bonds herein authorized as well as the costs of constructing, purchasing, improving or repairing District buildings, purchasing firefighting and rescue equipment or apparatus, and acquiring any land incidental to such purposes?"
