

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

From the office of County Clerk, Dodge County, Nebraska

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, at the following polling places in the precincts of Dodge County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 A.M. and will close at 8:00 P.M.

I would like to encourage all voters to consider voting early by applying through the mail. Absentee Ballots are now referred to as Early Voting. Years ago the Legislature removed all indications of requirements of being absent or disabled on Election Day. To issue an early ballot your signature or the signature of an agent acting in your behalf is needed. An application is available on the county's website at the bottom of the Election Commission tab <https://dodgecounty.nebraska.gov/election-commission>

Said election will be held for electing candidates to various offices.

IMPORTANT: LB 411, passed by the Legislature in 2018 with it going into effect for this election cycle, removes the exemptions of villages and township officers from having to file write-in affidavits to be counted as a write-in vote. Therefore, in this election and forward, NO write-in votes have to be counted in all races unless a voter files a notarized write-in affidavit by October 23rd. This is critical this year and two years from now with township boards since most villages in Dodge County will be electing three out of the five member Board of Trustees. Since there would not be a majority left on the Board, the remaining board members cannot appoint successors and a special election would have to be held.

Voters in the City of Fremont will be voting on a Proposed \$10,317,000 Bond Issue to build a Joint Law Enforcement Center and all voters of Dodge County will be voting on a Proposed \$7,783,000 Bond Issue to build a Joint Law Enforcement Center. The proposed building will house both the City of Fremont's Police Department and the Dodge County Sheriff's office.

All voters will be given two proposed amendments to the State Constitution brought to the people by the Legislature and three Initiatives Measures 428, 430, & 431 which will change statutes and Initiative Measure 429 will change the State Constitution which were proposed by petitions signed by the voters. A true copy of the ballot title and text will be published by the Secretary of State once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.
