- Sign-Up Forms must be received by the County Clerk/Election Commissioner on or before Monday, July 11, 2022 at 5:00p.m. in order for a voter to be added to the list prior to the November 8, 2022 General Election.
- Sign-Up Forms may be mailed or delivered to 435 N Park Room 102, Fremont, NE 68025; faxed to (402) 727-2764; or a high resolution scanned image or picture of the completed form may be emailed to clerk@DodgeCountyNE.gov "Request List Sign Up" as the subject.
- An Absentee/Early Voter application will be mailed approximately 2 to 3 months prior to each scheduled election hereafter.
- The Absentee/Early Voter application must be completed, physically signed, and returned in order to have an early voting ballot mailed to you.
- If you prefer to vote at your polling place on Election Day, you do not need to complete this form.
- The penalty for election falsification is imprisonment for up to two (2) years and twelve months post-release supervision or a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or both.
